How To Set Up And Use The Withings Body Scale

This information will explain how to set up and take a weight using the Withings Body Scale.

How to set up your Withings Body Scale

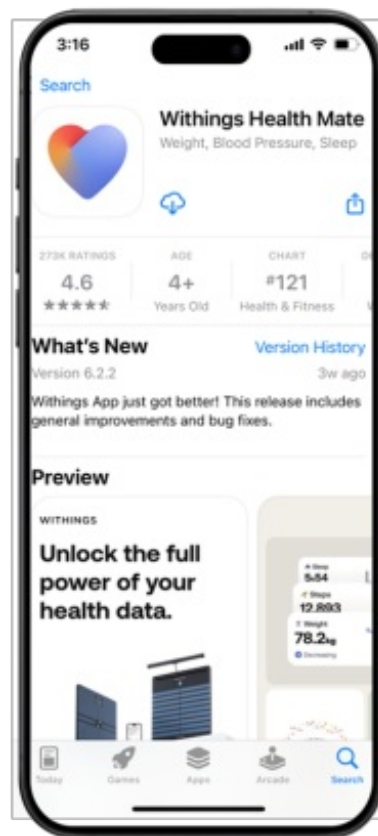


Figure 1. Withings Health Mate app

1. Download the Withings Health Mate app from iOS or Google Play Store (see Figure 1).

2. Select “Get Started” (see Figure 2).

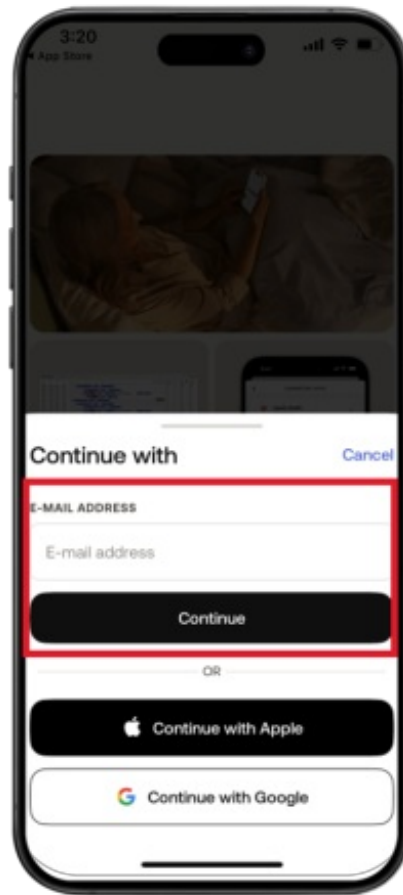


Figure 3. Enter your email

3. Enter the email address you would like to sign up with and click “Continue” (see Figure 3).

4. Check your email address for a Withings verification code. Enter the code into the Withings Health Mate App and click “Continue” (see Figure 4).

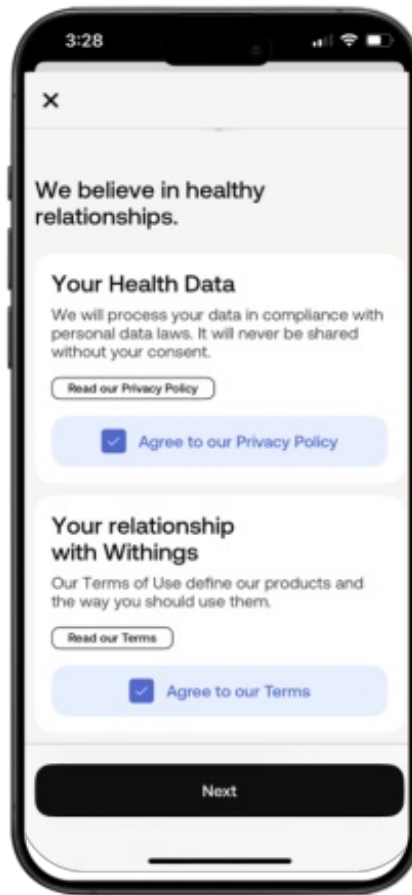


Figure 5. Privacy policy terms

5. Review the Withings Health Mate Privacy Policy and Terms. Select the checkboxes and click “Next” (see Figure 5).

6. Enter your First Name and Last Name and tap “Continue” (see Figure 6).

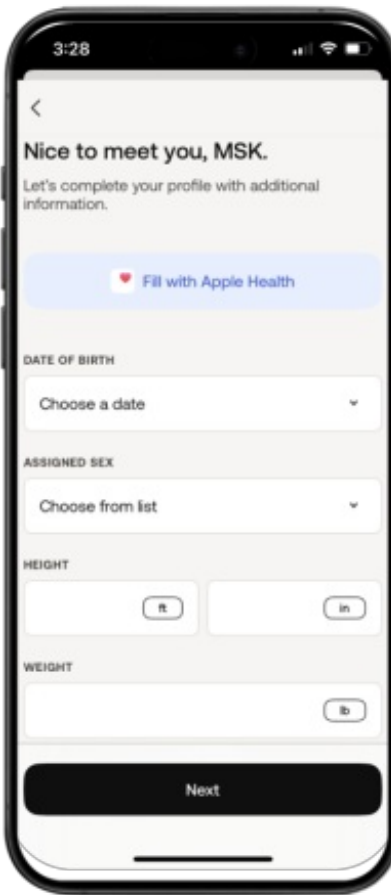


Figure 7. Finish your profile

7. Continue to create your profile. Enter your date of birth, assigned sex, height, and weight. Tap “Next” (see Figure 7).

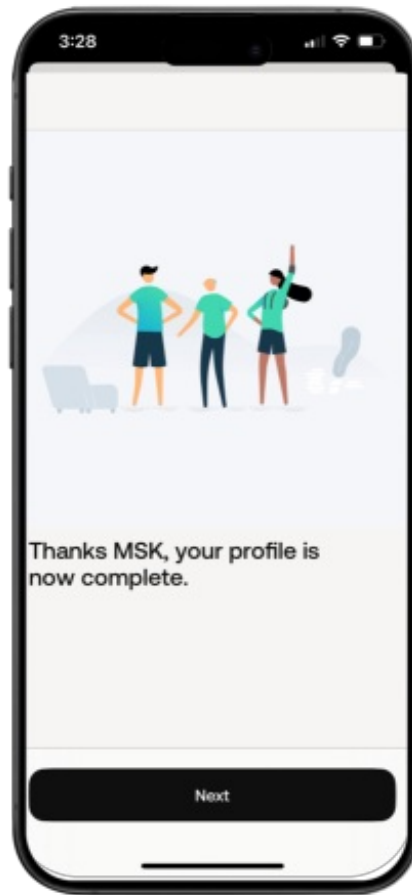


Figure 8. Your profile is complete

8. Your profile is now setup. Tap “Next” to continue (see Figure 8).

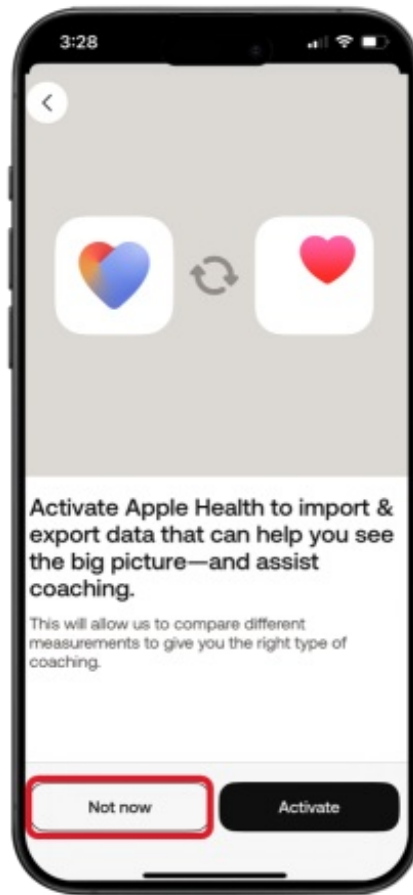


Figure 9. Do not activate

9. You will see a screen that asks you about activating Apple Health. Tap “Not now” (see Figure 9).

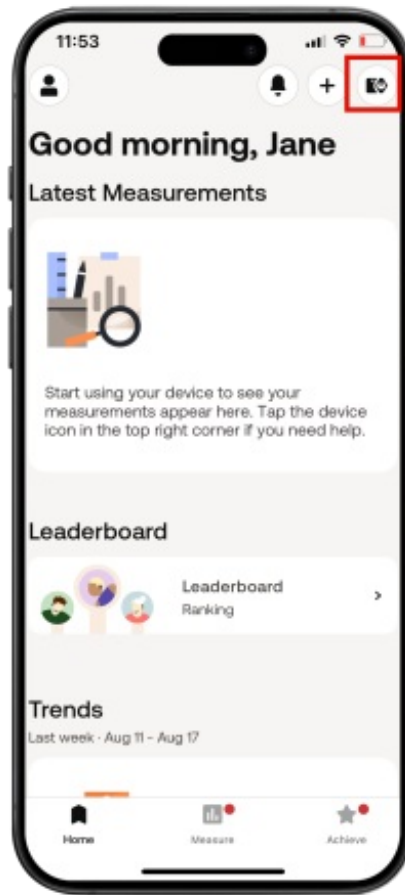


Figure 10. Open device selection

10. From top right-hand corner of the Home screen, tap the “Devices” icon (see Figure 10).

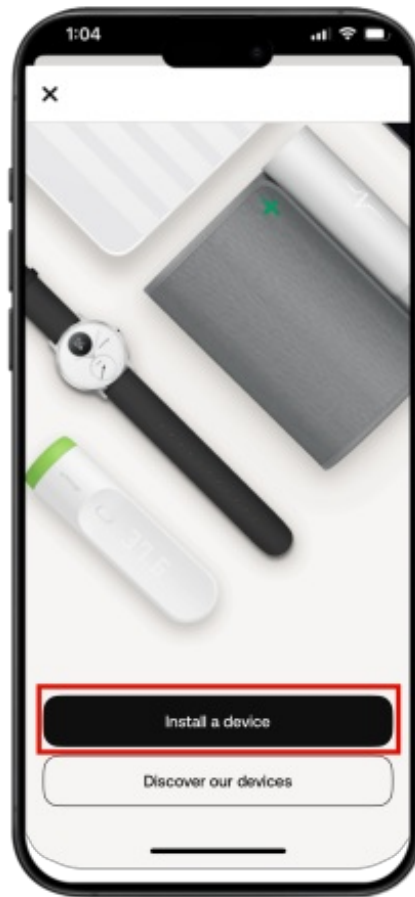


Figure 11. Install device

11. Tap the “Install a device” (see Figure 11).

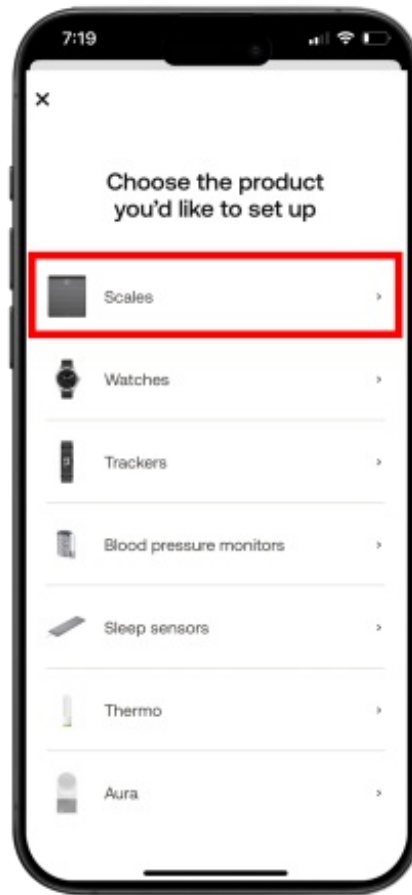


Figure 12. Select Scales

12. Select “Scales” from list (see Figure 12).

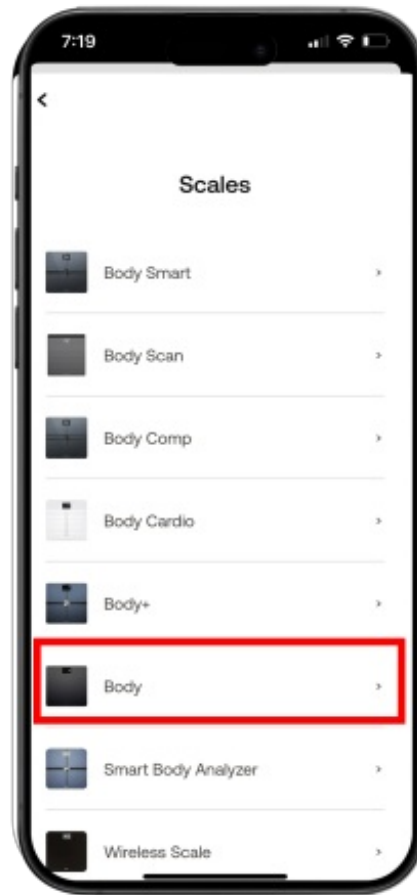


Figure 13. Select Body scale

13. Select “Body” from the list (see Figure 13).

14. Select “Install” (see Figure 14).

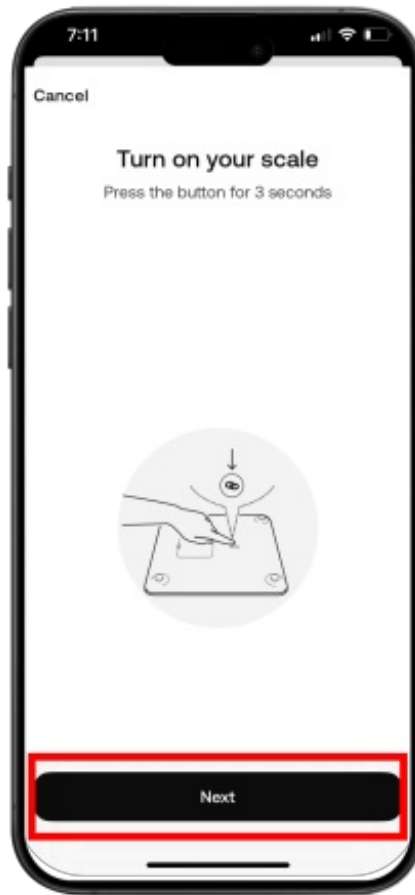


Figure 15. Turn on the scale

15. Flip your scale over. Press and hold the power button for 3 seconds. You will see the screen on the front light up. Tap “Next” in the Withings Health Mate app (see Figure 15).

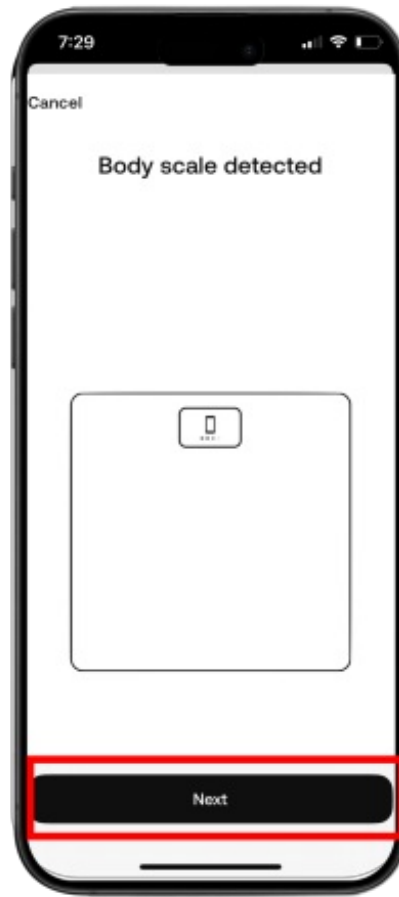


Figure 16. Body scale found

16. Once the Body scale is detected tap “Next” (see Figure 16).

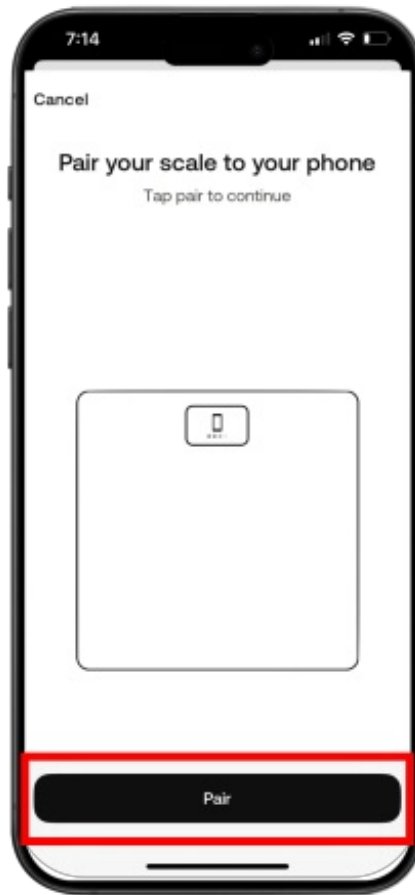


Figure 17. Start to pair device

17. Tap “Pair” to start pairing the scale (see Figure 17).

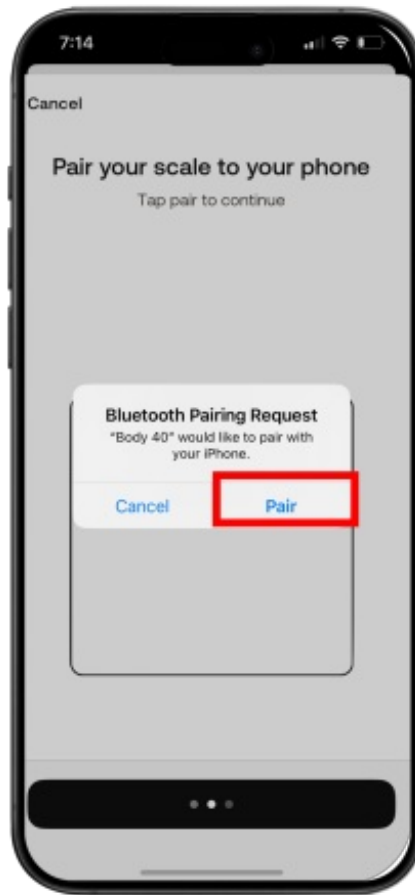


Figure 18. Bluetooth pairing

18. Tap “Pair” when the Bluetooth Pairing Request appears (see Figure 18).

19. Tap “Next” (see Figure 19).

20. Tap “I don’t have Wi-Fi”. The phone will be setup to connect to Bluetooth (see Figure 20).

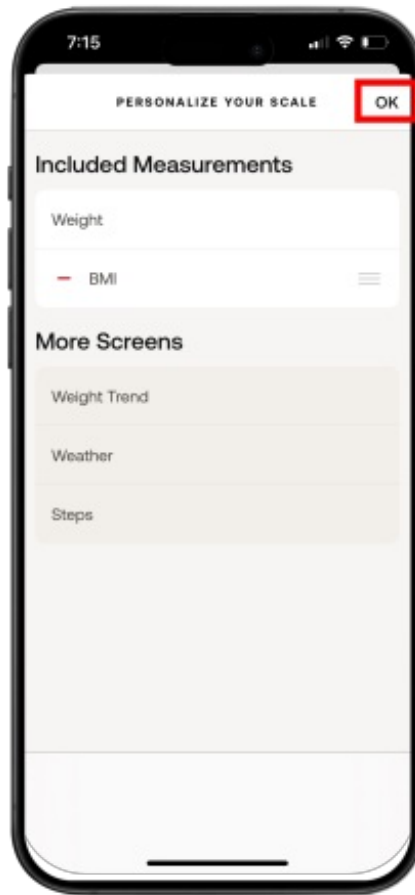


Figure 21. Set up BMI measurement

21. To setup scale, tap “BMI”. Then tap “OK” in the top right-hand corner (see Figure 21).

22. The scale setup is complete. Tap “Next” (see Figure 22).

How to get a weight on your Body Scale

1. To get your weight, step onto your Body scale with both feet flat on the scale.
2. The numbers will change and flash twice when done. Tap “Done” (see Figure 23).

3. You can review your weight on the Withings Health Mate app. The reading may take a few minutes to show up.

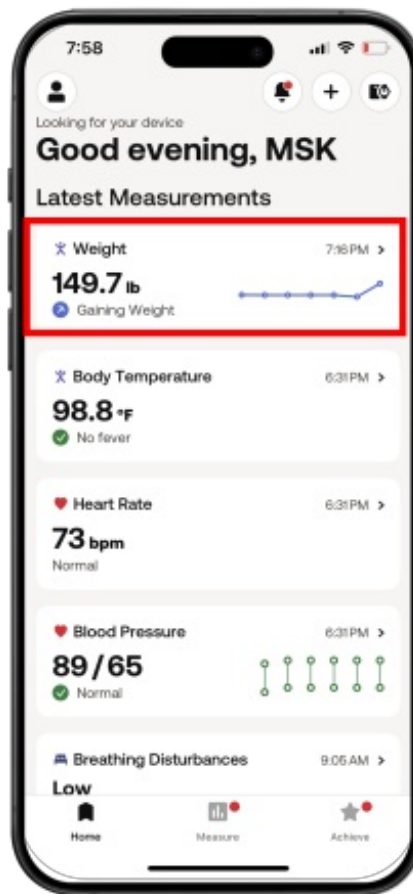


Figure 24. Your weight will be sent to MSK

4. Tap “Home” from the menu at the bottom. Your reading will automatically be sent to your care team at MSK. (see Figure 24).
