

STATSEAL ADVANCED DISC PRODUCTS for Fistula or Graft Procedures

A StatSeal® Advanced Disc product has been applied to your procedural site for the external control of bleeding from a procedure.

StatSeal is a topical compressed powder dressing that:

- Stops bleeding at the procedural site
- Forms a protective seal or scab over the site
- Is brown in color, due to the ingredients, and is encased in a foam shell
- Is available in both round and rectangular shapes

Dressing Removal & Site Care

Leave dressing in place for 24 hours. Avoid strenuous activity, per your physician's orders. The dressing may be removed after 24 hours, or as directed by your physician. A small scab will remain at the procedural site. Do not scrub or forcefully remove the scab. The scab will fall off naturally over time.

Call your physician if you notice any of the following:

- Bleeding or drainage at the procedural site
- Increased pain, swelling or redness

The dressing over the procedural site will look similar to one of the above photos, depending on whether the round or rectangular StatSeal Disc was used.

A small scab remains after dressing removal. Leave scab in place until it falls off naturally.
