Chemical Biology Summer Program (ChBSP)

June 2 – August 8, 2025

Applications are invited from chemistry, biochemistry and chemical biology juniors interested in pursuing research at the interface of chemistry and biomedicine.

Participants will:

- Adapt their chemistry skills to answer biomedically-focused research questions in cutting-edge laboratories at Rockefeller University, Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center, and Weill Cornell Medicine.
- Interact with faculty, postdoctoral fellows, and graduate students.
- Attend weekly seminar series of presentations by faculty.
- Attend professional development workshops.
- Present a poster at the end of the program.
- Receive a stipend of \$6,500 for the summer. Housing available.

We strongly encourage students from groups historically underrepresented in science (disadvantaged, disabled, Black, Hispanic/LatinX, Native American) to apply.
