Product Sheet: FACE-Q®

The FACE-Q® questionnaire is a rigorously developed PROM including multiple independently functioning scales/checklists that measure outcomes important to patients from their perspective. It can be used to measure treatment outcomes relating to aesthetics, head and neck cancers, paralysis, and skin cancers.

With broad applicability, the FACE-Q® questionnaire has been extensively utilized in clinical research and both cosmetic and therapeutic product development. The FACE-Q® modular approach allows clinicians and researchers to administer the subset of scales relevant to their situation.

In 2022, 11 of the FACE-Q® Aesthetic module scales were qualified by the U.S. FDA as Medical Device Development Tools. These scales measure appearance (face, cheeks, lips, skin, nasolabial folds, and glabella lines) and health-related quality of life (aging appraisal, early life impact of treatment, satisfaction with outcome, psychological function, and social function).

Potential applications include:

- **Research:** Can be used in research studies and clinical trials to study different approaches to treatment.
- Industry R&D: Carefully designed to meet the requirements of regulatory bodies.
- Benchmarking: Can be used to benchmark outcomes in quality improvement initiatives.
- Patient Care: Designed using a modern psychometric approach to facilitate use in patient care.

Licensing

Licensing fees vary, depending upon the number of scales selected, the number of patients, and the field of use (eg, clinical trials run by a for-profit entity or an electronic platform for PROMs administration).
